WHAT ATTRIBUTES DO YOU NEED TO BE A BEAUTY OR SPA THERAPIST

Beauty and Spa Therapy is a service career so it tends to suit people who love dealing with people and enjoy the rewards of making them look and feel better. Other traits that are important to have are:

- 1. A passion and interest in beauty, skincare or spa therapies.
- 2. Excellent communication and interpersonal skills and sensitive to each individual client's needs. Customer service is one of the most important elements of this role.
- 3. Pride in providing treatments which are of a high quality.
- 4. Interested and open to learning about new techniques and skills.
- 5. A high level of professionalism which includes being discreet with client information. For some clients you will be a shoulder to lean on, so it's important to keep any personal information to yourself.
- 6. Positive and calm.
- 7. Work well as part of a team.
- 8. An interest in hygiene and keeping clients safe.
- 9. Ability to soft sell products that will benefit your clients.
- 10. Punctual and organised. Providing treatments requires you to organise your time and be prepared.
- 11. The role can be physically demanding particularly where massage is concerned so a certain level of fitness and stamina is required.
- 12. Quite often you will need to work shifts including weekends so being flexible in your approach to the business is important.





QUALIFICATIONS

Qualifications play an important and essential part in the career of a beauty or spa therapist and involve the candidate taking both practical and theory examinations. These qualifications confirm your competence as a therapist and give reassurance to your clients. They will also fulfil any insurance requirements you may need to do your job.

The entry requirements to becoming a qualified beauty therapist or spa therapist vary from country to country but you will generally need a minimum level of exam achievement at school to be accepted onto a college course. Alternatively, there are specialist courses run by private training schools and bodies. Always do your own research into the best course for you to ensure the qualification you are studying for is giving you the best possible skills and is widely recognised by employers. A good course will not only teach you the skills but it will also help you gain the confidence to secure the best possible job once you are qualified.

The more qualifications you hold and experience you have, the more well-rounded your education will be and your ability to help clients will be greater. This is one of the great joys of being a beauty or spa therapist, there is always something new and interesting to learn which can help you move more easily up the career ladder.

You can become a beauty therapist, spa therapist, facialist, salon manager, spa manager, spa director, wellness manager, nail technician, makeup artist, massage therapist, mobile therapist, salon owner, cosmetic counter consultant, and even run your own beauty or spa business. With further training you can also choose to specialise in a specific skill such as reflexology, aromatherapy, certain types of massage, reiki etc.

Alternatively, some therapists move into working for beauty brands or product houses and other suppliers working within the industry in sales, marketing and other management positions. And these are just some of the opportunities.

It's a flexible role and you can work as much, or as little as you like so it's the perfect job for working around a family or combining with other interests. It's also one you can come back to after a career break.

Many CIDESCO members who have started as beauty therapists have gone on to have long and rewarding careers, at the same time forging valuable, long term friendships.




I completed my professional beauty education in Oslo and graduated in December 1991. I am also a member of SHR, the Swedish House Therapists' National Organization.


MENTORS FOR CAREER ADVANCEMENT

Mentorship can provide numerous benefits for someone starting out in the industry. This includes:

- 1. Knowledge and information when you start out in the beauty or spa business, there's a lot you have to learn. A mentor can share their own experience and skills with you, helping you to work smarter, avoid mistakes leading you to fast-track your career. This information often extends to general business advice around business planning, handling daily operations and making strategic decisions.
- 2. Clear Insights when someone has experience, they can often see clearly where we need to improve by providing honest constructive criticism. By understanding our weaknesses we know how to improve and grow.
- 3. Personal Development we are all different so a good mentor will understand how to encourage each individual's personal growth to bring out our best assets.
- 4. Encouragement sometimes it's difficult to keep pushing ourselves and developing. A mentor is always there to cheer us on and provide the necessary guidance when we need it.
- 5. Sounding Board having someone to discuss your ideas and thoughts with is extremely valuable, especially when you know you will receive an honest opinion. This can help you avoid time going in the wrong direction and encourage you more in areas which shows potential.
- 6. Connections mentors can often provide access to others within the industry that could be of benefit to you for their skills and own contacts. This industry networking might include trusted suppliers, new partnerships and even funding for your business.

CIDESCO QUALIFICATIONS

A CAREER IN BEAUTY & SPA THERAPY

CIDESCO offers a choice of over 24 courses to gain an internationally recognised qualification to work in the beauty or spa industry. Here we spotlight three of our most popular qualifications for starting a career as a beauty or spa therapist.

BEAUTY THERAPY DIPLOMA

Our most popular course for newcomers to the industry which will equip them with the required skills to operate as a beauty therapist for the face and body. Students must undergo a course of at least 1200 hours of training in practical and theoretical work in a registered CIDESCO School. On completion of the course, students take the CIDESCO Examination which consists of: facial examination, body examination, project and written examination.

SKINCARE DIPLOMA

This qualification provides candidates the required information and qualification to be able to efficiently and effectively work as skin care therapists including facials with electrical treatments, waxing and make-up. Candidates are required to have completed a course of at least 690 hours at a registered CIDESCO School covering all subjects in the CIDESCO Skin Care Syllabus.

SPA THERAPY DIPLOMA

This Spa Therapy course is a complete training course which does not require the student to have any previous Beauty or Spa Therapy knowledge. It encompasses all areas of Spa Therapy enabling the graduate to safely and effectively gain employment within the world-wide Spa industry. Candidates are required to have completed a course of at least 600 hours at a registered CIDESCO school, covering the Spa Therapy Training Syllabus.
